Using the Venngage infographic creator website (<https://venngage.com/>) and the links on my website, create a visually rich & coherent infographic which represents four important points you've learned about incarceration statistics in the two states you've been assigned.

Excellent infographics will:

- demonstrate insightful selection of details
- be well-researched and correctly cited
- have appropriate imagery, coloration, & background
- convey information clearly & creatively
- be thematically consistent throughout

We've begun work on the Venngage website in class. Remember two important points:

1. Venngage will only save five of your infographics. If you get a message that you need to pay to upgrade, delete some of your old infographics.
2. You can review and modify any infographic which is saved on your account. If you forget how to do something in Venngage, hover over the Basic or Intermediate tutorial infographics & click "Edit". You can then review how to make adjustments.

Cite your source whenever you use information that isn't common knowledge. Citations should be one word in small font (8pt.) near the base of the chart that contains the data (or below the quote). The full citation should be MLA format (also 8pt. font) at the end/bottom of your infographic.

Your final infographic is due on Friday, March 27. Be prepared to explain why you chose the visuals, organization, and layout that you did.
